


























Q.13: Which of the following improvements would you most like your school to make (Choose ONE)?
































Q.1: Since the beginning of the school year, how often have you...communicated with your child's teacher about your child's performance?


Q.2: Since the beginning of the school year, how often have you...seen your child's projects, artwork, homework, tests, or quizzes?


Q.3: During the school year, have you...attended a general school meeting or school event (virtually or inperson)?






Q.2: I trust the principal/school leader at their word (to do what they say that they will do).






